- Design and implement product-specific public affairs strategies in collaboration with cross-functional teams to support market access and business goals.
- Provide expert political and policy analysis, monitoring trends and advising senior management on potential impacts and strategic responses.
- Role model Novartis culture and lead talent development, fostering a high-performance team and ensuring capability growth within the assigned area.
